Creative	
<p style="text-align: center;">Yes:</p> <p>Then it should look creative. This includes creative portraits, creative candid people and creative black and whites.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">No:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Continue ↓</p>

Portrait	
<p style="text-align: center;">Yes:</p> <p>If you controlled the lighting, posing, etc. Portrait may be color or black and white.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">No:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Continue ↓</p>

Candid People	
<p style="text-align: center;">Yes:</p> <p>You did not control the lighting, posing, etc. You caught the image in the moment, not staged. May be color or b/w. Does not include Performance Art such as dance, concert, stage and historical fairs and festivals, where the craftsmen are in period attire or costumes. Color Performance Art goes in Open.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">No:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Continue ↓</p>

B/W, Sepia, Infrared	
<p style="text-align: center;">Yes:</p> <p>The B/W category includes B/W, Sepia or IR Performance Art, Landscapes, Nature and domesticated and zoo animals.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">No:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Continue ↓</p>

Nature	
<p style="text-align: center;">Yes:</p> <p>This includes botanical specimens photographed indoors or in other locations. Domesticated or restrained wildlife should be placed in Open Category or B/W if Black and White.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">No:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Continue ↓</p>

Scenic/Landscape	
<p style="text-align: center;">Yes:</p> <p>This includes seascapes, cityscapes and woodland field shots.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">No:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Continue ↓</p>

Open	
<p style="text-align: center;">Yes:</p> <p>This includes color Performance Art; color domesticated animals and zoo animals and all other color images that do not belong elsewhere.</p>
